

Checklist for Property Owners to Obtain Septic System (or Lagoon)
Construction Permit

- 1. Soil Test Holes have been installed with a backhoe and approved by the Health Department?
- 2. Approval of Water Supply: If rural water is being utilized, owner has secured a letter from the rural water district that a meter has been purchased?
- 3. If well water or cistern will be utilized, owner has secured a permit from the Health Department? *
*Note: New wells and cisterns are not allowed within the Urban Growth Area upon properties divided after Jan. 1, 2007.
- 4. Owner has secured a letter of approval for a “Lot Buildability” statement issued by the Zoning and Codes Department?
- 5. A site plan has been drawn up by a licensed septic system installer?
- 6. Owner has a copy of the legal description of the property?
- 7. The septic system permit application has been filled out?
