"KIDS NEED TO KNOW" IS A FAMILY-BASED SEXUALITY EDUCATION COURSE

The family is the logical sexuality education source for young people. We believe that parents/guardians need and want to be involved in the sexuality education of their children, but often do not know what or how to teach them.

HELPING PARENTS/GUARDIANS TO BE SEX EDUCATORS

The Lawrence-Douglas County Health Department's Family-Based Sexuality Education Course assists parents and guardians in their efforts to be the primary sexuality educators for their children. A parent or legal guardian attends each class with the child. The course goal is to facilitate family communication on the subject of sexuality.

MORE THAN JUST THE "FACTS OF LIFE"

Structured group activities encourage sharing of the parent's and youth's feelings and beliefs about sexuality. Exploring this essential aspect of sexuality is the special privilege of the family and provides the background against which the "facts" of sexuality can be applied.

COURSE STRUCTURE

Parents' Night:

All courses begin with a "parents only" night during which curriculum and materials are discussed and any questions are answered.

Weekly Sessions:

After Parents' Night, the courses continue with weekly parent-child sessions for four more weeks. One parent accompanies the child to each class, which is approximately two hours in length.

Reproductive body parts and purposes, puberty, pregnancy, childbirth and sexually transmitted diseases are discussed. Decision-making skills are emphasized.

Videos, games and other interactive activities help make the classes fun and interesting.
