## **Douglas County Preparedness Fair to be held Saturday**

**(Lawrence, KS)** – Natural disasters are unpredictable and can cause power failure, impede travel and make obtaining food and supplies difficult.

Think of these things before a crisis occurs and learn ways to be prepared at the Douglas County Preparedness Fair from 9 to 11 a.m. Saturday, Sept. 26 at the Douglas County Fairgrounds, 2120 Harper St. The event is free to attend and is sponsored by Douglas County Emergency Management, the Lawrence-Douglas County Health Department, Roger Hill Volunteer Center and Together Prepared.

The fair will include booths from the Lawrence-Douglas County Fire & Medical's "Safety House," the Lawrence Humane Society, Douglas County Medical Reserve Corps and Eudora Police Department's "Ident-a-kid."

Take this opportunity to prepare you and your family for future events. In addition to attending the fair, residents can prepare themselves by taking these steps:

- **Get a kit** - When preparing for an emergency situation, think about the basics of survival: bottled water, food and necessary personal items such as prescriptions needed to sustain yourself and your family for at least three days.
- **Make a plan** - Your family may not be together when disaster strikes, so it is important to plan in advance: how you will contact each other and where you will meet.
- **Stay informed** - Learn more about the potential emergencies (natural and man-made) that can happen where you live and the appropriate way to respond to them. In addition, learn about the emergency plans established in your area by your state and local government, including Douglas County Emergency Management and the Lawrence-Douglas County Health Department.
