### **Eudora, Baldwin H1N1 vaccination clinics rescheduled**

**(Lawrence, KS)**- The Lawrence-Douglas County Health Department has rescheduled H1N1 vaccination clinics in Eudora and Baldwin City. The clinics were canceled due to last week's snow storm.

The new clinic dates and locations are:

- **Jan. 20**- 4 to 6:30 p.m., Eudora Middle School, 2635 Church St., Eudora.
- **Feb. 4**- 4:30 to 6:30 p.m., Baldwin High School, 415 Eisenhower St., Baldwin City.

As part of the federal vaccination program, the H1N1 immunization is available at no charge.

The Health Department encourages children under 10, who have received their first dose of the H1N1 vaccine, to receive their second booster immunization at the upcoming clinics. A period of one month must have passed between the child's first and second doses.

To help expedite the process, clients planning to be immunized at Health Department H1N1 clinics are encouraged to download a consent form at [www.ldchealth.org](http://www.ldchealth.org), fill it out ahead of time and bring to a clinic. A second consent form must be filled out for children receiving their second dose.

The H1N1 vaccination is also available through the Health Department's regular walk-in clinic. Hours include Monday evenings (with the exception of Monday, Jan. 18, the Martin Luther King Day holiday). Visit [www.ldchealth.org](http://www.ldchealth.org) for complete clinic hours.
