Legislative health forum scheduled for Monday

(Lawrence, KS) – The public is invited to attend a legislative health forum, hosted by the Lawrence-Douglas County Health Department and the Kansas Public Health Association at 10 a.m. Monday, April 14 at the Community Health Facility's second floor meeting room, 200 Maine St. in Lawrence.

State Sen. Roger Pine, R-Lawrence, Rep. Paul Davis, D-Lawrence, Rep. Stan Frownfelter, D-Kansas City, Kan., and Sen. David Haley, D-Kansas City, Kan., will provide legislative updates on Kansas health reform. Other local and regional legislators have also been invited to attend.

Topics will include health reform issues before the Kansas Legislature, as well as preparedness efforts for pandemic flu. The forum will conclude with a brief question and answer session. Fifteen other Kansas cities are holding similar legislative events scheduled throughout April.
