### **New Director of Clinic Services named**

**(Lawrence, KS)** – The Lawrence-Douglas County Health Department has named Nurse Kim Ens director of clinic services.

Ens, who has worked at the Health Department for the past 17 years, succeeds Barbara Schnitker, who retired after 26 years of service in June. Ens' duties include: overseeing day-to-day clinic operations, supervising the agency's 10 nurses, developing protocols and planning.
