

Current LMH Health Inpatients Positive for COVID-19: **0**

- Douglas County’s Unified Command leadership has agreed to adopt the Governor’s Phase 2 under a [local health order](#) that started May 27, which will keep bars, nightclubs and swimming pools closed and prohibits mass gatherings of 15 or more people through at least June 7.
