

- Douglas County’s Local Health Officer Dr. Thomas Marcellino will [extend Phase 3](#) of the county’s Smart & Safe Reopening Plan for two weeks through July 5: “We have seen an uptick in recent activity suggesting the coronavirus has become more active in our county, and I believe it’s more prudent to extend Phase 3 for two more weeks so we can get an idea of the trend of the virus and prevent chances for large mass gatherings that could potentially be a source of a large outbreak that could be devastating.”
